## **Instructor's Notes:**

- In addition to performing the steps listed in the skill charts in the correct order, participants must meet the criteria as outlined in the skill assessment tools at the proficient level to be checked off for a skill.
- The skills may need modification for participants with disabilities or other conditions. This awareness challenges instructors to focus on the components of a skill that are needed to successfully complete an objective, as opposed to perfecting every facet of the skill. Always teach to the standard, but be aware that participants may modify how a skill is accomplished and still meet the objective. Test participants' skills accordingly.
- All skill sessions include practicing with appropriate standard precautions, such as using a resuscitation mask and disposable (single-use) gloves.
